



SARTELL COMMUNITY CENTER CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL AREAS OF BUILDING:

- You must be participating in a program or rental, or have paid the daily fee to use this facility except for use of the Granite Logistics Resource Center.
- Children 5th grade and under must have an accompanying adult present within the building.
- Inappropriate use of equipment is not permitted.
- Clean up and report spills to staff.
- Please report any faulty equipment to a staff member immediately.
- Please dispose of all trash in the proper bins.
- Sartell Community Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items. It is strongly recommended that you do not bring any valuables into the facility. Please store all personal items on the coat racks or in the storage cubbies/lockers provided (no locks permitted on lockers overnight).

GYM SPECIFIC CONDUCT includes the above as well as:

- Proper athletic attire including shirt, shorts/pants, and clean, dry, non-marking athletic shoes must be worn.
- During wet weather please bring clean, dry shoes to change into prior to entering the gym.
- Report any issues, injuries or incidents to the front desk staff immediately.
- Plastic or metal spill-proof water containers are permitted - no glass allowed. No food is permitted
- Dunking or hanging on the basketball rims is strictly prohibited.
- Do not hang on pickleball or volleyball nets.
- No kicking or sitting on basketballs or volleyballs.
- No music permitted without headphones.
- When an activity has ended, leave the gym floor promptly so the next scheduled activity can begin.
- NO organized practices except for programs or rentals.
- Good sportsmanship is expected for all activities.

The following activities are not permitted in any area and may result in suspension, expulsion or termination of facility use, and/or criminal punishment:

Fighting, profanity/foul language or clothing, disorderly conduct, bullying, threatening or aggressive behavior, spitting, use of alcohol, vaping or tobacco products, theft, property damage, littering, loitering (inside or outside of the facility), defrauding membership, public displays of affection, excessive horseplay, disregarding the staffs' enforcement of the rules.
